Dear brethren,

the Sixth Commandment is: You shall not commit adultery! Throughout Holy Scripture, however, we can observe that the intent of this Commandment, rather than merely to address the most obvious manifestation of sexual immorality, is to hold the sanctity of marriage before us. Let marriage be held in honour among all, as the Letter to the Hebrews writes it, and let the marriage bed be undefiled, for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterous.

## Hebrews 13:4

And marriage *is* sacred to God, not only as an imagery of His salvation, but also as a reflection of His very own nature; well, those could be said to be the same, since it is in His salvation of sinners God reveals His goodness to be His very innermost nature, and who really is, at heart.

God the Father, who is the Father in God, is He after whom all fatherhood is named, writes the holy Apostle Paul, or every family, as the Greek word also could (but should not) be translated. **Ephesians 3:15** 

According to Holy Scripture, marriage is the foundation of family life, because it is that according to the ordinance and arrangement of God; as Holy Scripture says it, with regards to marriage: A man shall leave his father and mother and bind himself to his wife, and they shall become one flesh. Genesis 1:26, 27

This is the foundation of all family life according to Holy Scripture: A man is emancipated from his home and family to be established himself as the head of another. And this ordinance is founded in the very nature of God, and the life the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit shared from eternity, in love. As Holy Scripture teaches it: In the beginning, God the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit said to Himself, and to each other: Let us make Man in our image, after our likeness. And so He did. God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. Genesis 1:26, 27

As men and women, made to live together in love, we are made in His image, who is eternal love, to represent His goodness in the created world by our life together in love. And made in the image of God, as men and women, we have the precious privilege of taking part in His project of creation by bringing new life into the world, out of our life together in love.

Marriage is indeed a sacred ordinance, and one that is crucial to our life as servants of God, and to God Himself. Being born as either a man or a woman is fundamental to who we are before God, and His will for us and our lives. To live in the love of God, and reflect His love by living with someone of the sex opposite to our own, under a commitment and obligation to remain together and continue to each give oneself to the other in life, that is the purpose for which we were made to begin with (that this does not happen for all of us is a topic for another day). And this ordinance of God is a reflection of His very nature, who He Himself is.
